## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

The Miami County Right to Life Society (501C-4) and the Miami County Pro-Life Educational Foundation (501C-3) exist because so many in Miami County volunteer their time and talent in support of our mission. We offer a wide range of volunteer opportunities, and we have volunteers spanning all age groups. Volunteers are needed in the daytime, the evenings, and on weekends, depending on the service provided. Service can be offered sporadically or through a regular commitment. *Please consider sharing your God-given talents in support of our mission and vision.*

### Office Volunteer

Volunteers work at the Center for Life sorting and washing donated baby items, assisting clients, and answering phones.

### Purchasing

Volunteers donate their time to purchase diapers, cribs, and mattresses and to organize transportation to obtain purchased items.

### Client Education Facilitators

Volunteers share their relevant expertise with our clients as a facilitator in our crib program.

### Youth Outreach

Volunteers organize essay contests for students and seniors, and they assist the youth outreach coordinator as needed.

### Speaker's Bureau

Volunteers share their knowledge as representatives of MCRTL who speak regularly to groups and gatherings about pro-life issues.

### Special Events

Volunteers assist with a variety of activities and events, including showers/drives, Giving Tree projects, benefit parties, flower sales, and festivals.

### Prayer Support

Volunteers organize prayer vigils at abortion clinics and elsewhere, *March for Life* in D.C., *Life Chain* in Troy, and our prayer vigil in January.

### Maintenance

Volunteers assist with facility upkeep, fixing cribs, moving/hauling, mowing, and gardening.

### Professional Services

We appreciate advice and assistance to address a variety of needs, including grant writing, legal issues, counseling, and marketing.
